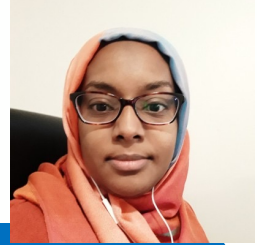

Sudan

Background

- Sadagaat Charity Organization is a non-profit established in 2002 as an initiative launched by a group of young Sudanese expatriates who settled abroad.
- Sadagaat was built-on a method of “**circles of trust**” whereby people were invited to participate in projects; with opinion, expertise, manpower and later financial contribution. Those participants were asked to invite family, friends and colleagues to participate, spreading the message of Sadagaat and creating the vast and diverse collective we proudly call *The Sadagaat Community*.
- At the organization’s core is transferring Private Sector “know-how and techniques” to administrating projects in the not-for-profit sector.
- Sadagaat was registered as an NGO in May 2012, with the relative authorities in Sudan

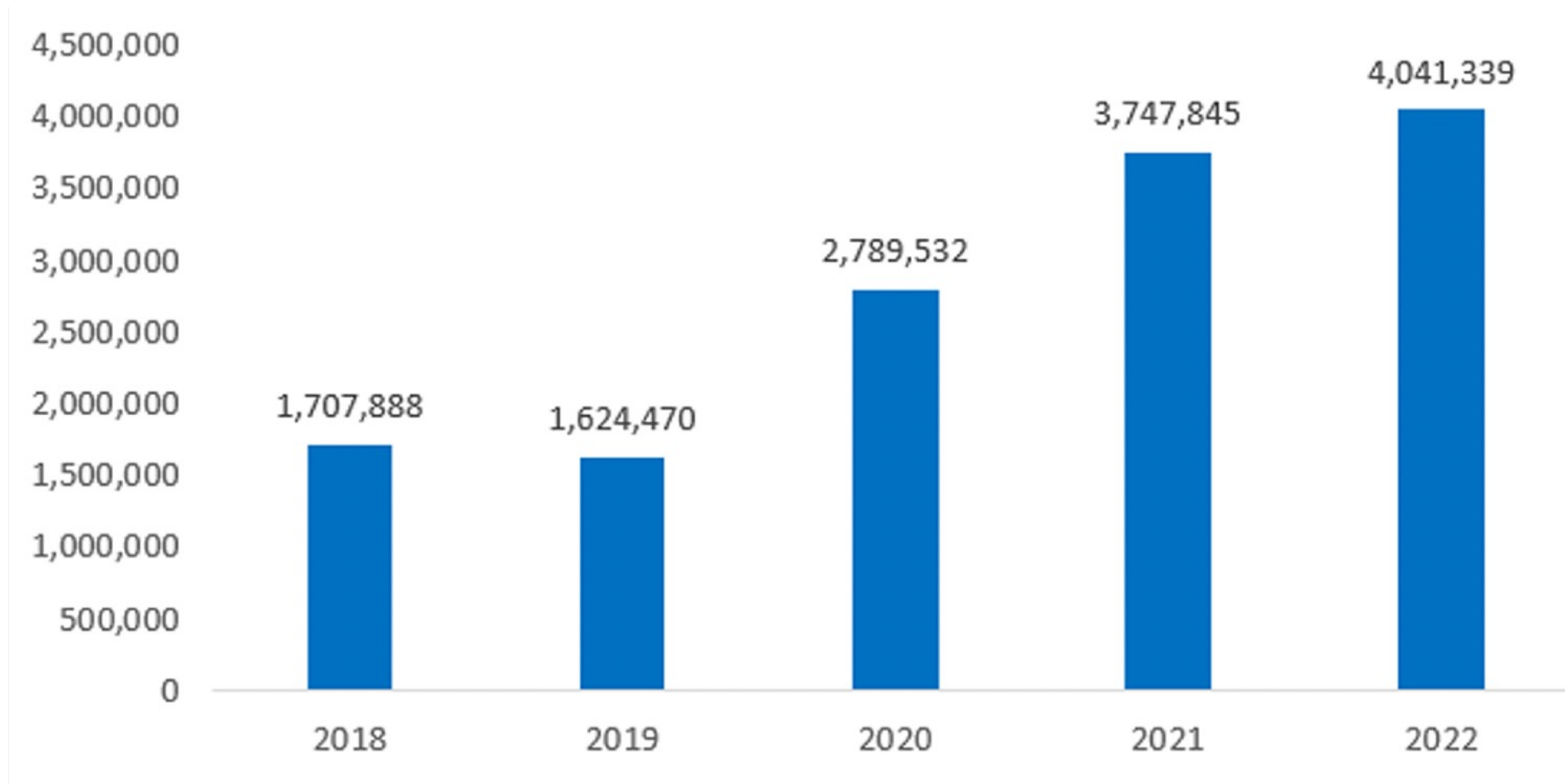

Ramadan Packages

This year's goal was to provide sustenance to Sudan's needy families by providing food packages containing basic ingredients used during Ramadan..

The distributed package contained basic supplies for these families, such as sugar, oil, corn flour, lentil, and wheat flour that were enough for a single family.



Zakat Fitr (Fitra)

Sadagaat-Canada partnered with IDRF to distribute Fitra to people in need in Palestine

Zakat Al-Fitr is a charitable donation of food that must be given before the Eid prayer, before the end of the month of Ramadan. It will be distributed to eligible families, and it is given in Flour, the local main ingredient of the food .



Ramadan FIDYA

Sadagaat-Canada partnered with IDRF to distribute FIDYA to people in need in Palestine

FIDYA is a charitable compensation paid when someone cannot fast in Ramadan and can't make up the lost days afterwards (for example, because of ill health or pregnancy), then they should pay (Fidya) for someone else to be fed.

Sudan Flood Campaign

Many of urgent need of shelter, clean water, sanitation and other emergency assistance were provided by our Partner Sadagaat, to the people affected by torrential rains and floods in the states of Nile River and Al-Jazeera.

Eid Aladha Udhiya

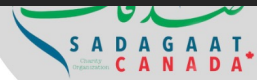
Sadagaat Canada performed sacrifices on the behalf of you and distributed them on your behalf of to poor families. A calf is shared between 7, and each share is equivalent to an Udhiya.

Support Internally Displaced People in Aljazeera & River Nile States

Objective

Contribute to stabilizing the humanitarian conditions of internally displaced people in Aljazeera and River Nile states.

An integrated package to provide shelters services to assist the communities and committees in alleviating the large economic burdens resulting from the disastrous situation left by the military conflicts

The project will assist IDP groups transiting and residing in Aljazeera and River Nile states (Wad Madani and Shandi localities), a border area visited by displaced people.

The project focuses on the following area of intervention:

1. Providing water supply.
2. Supporting personal hygiene and sanitation services
3. Purchasing and providing food items “Feeding”.

Critical Medical Equipment– Halfa Dialysis Center

Objective

Providing kidney care services in the northern state (Halfa locality) to sustain good health for kidney patients,

Increase the capacity of Halfa Dialysis Center by adding two machines to cover all patients who attend the center from halfa, Khartoum and border and support and operate the Halfa Kidney Center so that it can provide services to residents, displaced and transit citizens

The goal of this project is to

1. Ensure Dialysis center function and meet transit and displaced patient's needs.
2. Support services in the state by providing a dialysis machine for patients in Halfa Dialysis center.
3. Contribute to health system strengthening efforts by empowering health services.

Eid Al-Adha Udhiya

Objective

Feed people in need with Udhiya meat. Distributing the majority of this Eid- Al-Adha season to internally displaced people

As we do every year, Sadagaat performs Udhiya sacrifices on your behalf and distributes them to the people in need. Calves that meet the conditions of sacrifice are bought, slaughtered, and distributed to those entitled to them from poor families and vulnerable groups inside. This year we will focus on distributing Udhiya to internally displaced people in Aljazeera and River Nile states. A calf is shared between 7 and each share is equivalent to an Udhiya.
