Sadagaat Charity Organization operates through four sectors: “WASH, health, education, Feeding” and contributes to providing some of the basics and necessities of life.

WASH

Its primary focus is on 'water' as millions of Sudanese struggle to get clean water across the country.

HEALTH

Sadagaat considers health as one of the most important sectors as it has the closest connection to the quality of life.

EDUCATION

In the education sector, the organization aims to promote educational opportunities for vulnerable groups and segments, as well as contributing to raising the level of educational utilities.

FEEDING

The purpose of the "feeding" sector is to promote the concept of charity by providing feeding service in different periods of the year, such as the month of Ramadan and distribution of Zakat Al-Fitr and Sacrifice.





WASH

The sector of WASH: Water supply, environmental sanitation and personal hygiene.

Sadagaat work started on water supply, environmental sanitation and personal hygiene throughout Sudan in **2013**. Work is underway to implement **23** projects, which are projected for completion by the end of **2022**.

Charity works in this sector is divided into through **3** programs:

1. **Environment**
2. **Awareness**
3. **Training**



WASH PROGRAMS

WASH is divided into the following types of projects:

Underground well stations (**supplement and complete stations**)

There are areas where clean water sources are not available, forcing its residents to resort to unclean sources or to distant places (**most of the time distance is more than 3 km**) to bring clean water. Sadagaat community works to provide clean water to the residents of these areas by contracting specialized companies to implement the entire project.

This may include:

- well drilling
- supply and installation of solar powered submersible pump
- manufacture and installation of water tanks needed
- creating appropriate human and animal drinking locations
- constructing fences to protect water sources
- completing projects by carrying out maintenance
- supplying and installing a non-existent component



Conveyor Lines:

High amounts of pollution in the River Nile has resulted in underground water wells containing unsafe drinking water. The conveyor lines project is implemented along the main course of the River Nile where the presence of contaminated wells is most severe.

Prior to the installation of the conveyor lines, preliminary studies are carried out to determine the following:

- The level of water pollution contamination
- Size of the population in the community
- Length and diameter of the conveyor line needed
- Volume of water
- Types of pumps necessary for the project
- Possible location of a central station
- Type of water treatment needed
- Types of ground and upper tanks needed



Water Harvesting :

Water harvesting is the process of storing rainwater in the autumn season with the intention of later using it in times of drought. The primary goal of a water harvesting project is to provide drinking water for humans and animals in many states of Sudan. Throughout the country there are regions rich in seasonal surface unused water but contain almost non-existent sources of groundwater. These are in need for water harvesting projects.

Water harvesting projects support economic goals through agricultural intensification and diversification, increasing production in areas of traditional agriculture, and developing wealth via animal and forestry. In addition to affecting the economy of the community, it creates social goals by developing rural areas and creating additional job opportunities to stabilize its population and increase income. In turn this results in the increase in the standard of living.

To realize the concept of integrated water resources management, Sadagaat plans to implement a number of water harvesting projects in the coming years.



Thermal coolers for schools :

Sadagaat seeks to provide a source of clean, cooled water for the public schools by installing natural water coolers when possible. In the event that natural water coolers cannot be provided, Sadagaat employs the use of a motor or tank to ensure a continuous source of water for students. These coolers have a clear impact on student stability and lowering rates of disease associated with the unavailability of drinkable water.



Environmental Sanitation and Personal Hygiene Program :

The Environmental Sanitation and Personal Hygiene Program is divided into the following types of projects:

- Construction and maintenance of bathrooms in schools and health centers
- Distribution of waste baskets to hospitals and schools
- Installation of hand washing basins in schools and hospitals

Through experience and practicality, Sadagaat Charity Organization has begun to shift from the "Watering Sector" to WASH sector. The direct correlation between human health and environmental sanitation and hygiene led to the motivation to establish a healthy environment free of pathogens and outbreaks environmentally based.



Awareness and Training Program :

The Awareness and Training program is divided into the following types of projects:

Training the community on the management and operation of water stations.

Sadagaat creates and distributes informational packets explaining the methods of managing and operating water stations. These booklets contain a detailed explanation of the parts of the station, its operation, and methods of maintenance. A committee is trained in its upkeep and management to ensure stable water services.

Schools' Health Clubs

Water and hygiene services are a fundamental right of all school children. Sadagaat plans to provide hygiene supplies to improve the educational environment and keep students away from hygiene related diseases. This is achieved by supplying schools with the necessary utilities to prevent students from acquiring diseases associated with personal hygiene





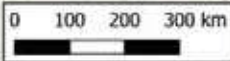

Sadagaat Awarded

Necklace of Prince Muhammad bin Fahd International Foundation for Voluntary Work

In 2020, the Sadagaat Charity Organization won the “Necklace of Prince Muhammad Bin Fahd International for Voluntary Work” in its third edition, organized by the Arab Volunteer Union in partnership with the Prince Muhammad Bin Fahd International Foundation. The award is sponsored by the League of Arab States with International Volunteer Day on the fifth of December every year. The competition prizes were distributed in six areas:

- environment
- water
- education
- heritage, culture and arts
- economic empowerment
- health
- marketing and social media.

The prize recognized the efforts of Sadagaat in the presentation of the award for the best volunteer work in the field of environment and water, and the impact of charity projects on watering which changed the lives of many people across the country.





Health

Sadagaat Charity Organization pays special attention to health as it is linked to the quality of life and contributes to a stable health reality. The organization has designed detailed programs for medical staff along with the creation of a clean and stable healthy environment. Sadagaat works through its activity in the health sector via 5 main programs:

1. Rehabilitation of health facilities
2. Awareness campaigns
3. Provision of treatment services
4. Training medical staff
5. Practicing telemedicine



Health Sector Program

Rehabilitation of Health Facilities:

Sadagaat targets rehabilitation of hospitals that provide medical services to a large number of patients who do not have the financial means for treatment. This is achieved through the maintenance of wards and intensive care units, as well as providing medical devices and equipment.

The rehabilitation of health facilities is divided into 4 types of projects:

- Restoration of hospitals and health centers
- Reintegration of laboratories
- Installation of oxygen networks
- Establishment of oxygen stations

Sadagaat established oxygen generators and installed oxygen networks in a number of hospitals to ensure a stable oxygen supply as a result of the growing urgent need for oxygen during and after the COVID-19 pandemic. The charity initiative was extended to include contributing to breaching the shortage of Oxygen as a result of the challenges associated with the deportation of oxygen cylinders to remote areas.



Awareness Campaigns :

Awareness campaigns aim to increase knowledge regarding health by providing the right information in order to change health related behaviors.

Sadagaat implements the following Awareness Campaigns

Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign

Among the annual health sector activities implemented by Sadagaat Charity Organization the “Because We Love You” campaign raised awareness of the dangers of breast cancer. Starting in 2014, Sadagaat advances awareness of breast cancer in October of each year to spread the culture of self-examination. In turn this expresses the importance of early detection in order to correct the misconceptions about breast cancer within the different states of Sudan.

Voluntary Blood Donation Campaign

One of the ongoing projects since 2014 that aims to spread the culture of voluntary blood donation in society. This is achieved through the correcting of misconceptions and for the provision of a safe blood stock for groups in need of blood. It is attained through corporate institutions and public places campaigns in partnership with the Blood Central Bank.



Providing Medical Services provides the following actions:

- Conducting eye operations
- Monthly treatment for children with kidney transplants
- Providing a place to stay during the isolation period following transplant operations and during the Corona pandemic
- Providing a large number of sterilizers and medical supplies to combat COVID-19 have been provided



Eye Operations :

Sadagaat has been working since 2014 to support eye patients through the initiative.

"Eyes See Hope" through financial relief for cataract and glaucoma operations. By October 2021, the number of beneficiaries reached more than 1,655 composed of 1,600 cataracts and 55 glaucoma patients.



Providing Medical Subsistence and Transportation Services for Children with Kidney Transplants :

In 2016 Sadagaat began the project to provide care and services for children undergoing kidney transplants. It supported the project both by providing emotional and financial aid and, in doing so, was able to bring dozens of children back from their sick beds to playgrounds and schools.

Sadagaat takes care of the necessary health care for children with kidney failure who underwent surgery at Nura Center at Soba University Hospital in Khartoum, the post-transplant care period extends throughout the recovery period



Nifaidi Health Center :

In 2015 the Al-Nifaidi Charity Group established the Omar Al-Nifaidi Health Center in Haj Yousuf, in the state of Khartoum. The Nifaidi Health Center provides medical services at a nominal cost, to serve the people of the region. The center was handed over to the Ministry of Health in the state of Khartoum.

In 2018, a memorandum of cooperation was signed between **Al-Nifaidi Group** and the **Sadagaat Community** to undertake the operation, supervision and periodic follow-up process of the center work and to pay the cost of running the center and the incentives of the employees on an ongoing basis. Additionally, Sadagaat is to provide solutions and laboratory needs of equipment and laboratory materials on a monthly basis.



Training of Medical Staff :

As part of its plans to upgrade the health sector in the country, Sadagaat aims to raise the level of efficiency of medical staff, including doctors, nurses and workers in the scientific and applied level to improve the medical services provided. The program includes training medical staff to operate intense care units and training volunteers in first aid.



Telemedicine:

Telemedicine is the use of information technology and communication electronic services to provide diagnosis, and medical examination of patients. It aims to facilitate communication between health practitioners and patients. Telemedicine also facilitated communication among doctors, whether or not related to consultations, scientific conferences, or medical educational activities. Telemedicine falls within the plans and strategy of Sadagaat to develop the health sector in the coming years.





Education

Education is the cornerstone of growth. Evolution in any society is dependent on the success of the educational system. Sadagaat greatly contributes in solving many problems that face the educational process in Sudan. The challenges faced include the lack of enrollment of school-age children, the deterioration in the standard of educational facilities, overcrowding in classrooms, deterioration of buildings and health facilities, and poor education assistance, particularly for children with special needs.

The Educational Axis is divided into six programs:

1. Accelerated education for out-of-school children
2. EMAAR
3. Education for children with disabilities
4. Vocational training
5. Capacity building program for education staff
6. Academic research



Education Sector Programs

Accelerated Education for Out-of-School Children :

Sadagaat started working on the Accelerated Learning Project (ALP) in 2017, in partnership with UNICEF, to address cases of student dropout from education. The program aims to bring out-of-school children to the educational ladder at the foundational stage and integrate them with their peers. The program extends to include contributing to stabilize admission by improving the school environment, providing meals and education aids, in addition to training teachers on the accelerated education curriculum.



EMAAR:

The "Emaar" (**Construction**) project started in 2019 renovating school buildings as well as building new classrooms and schools as needed. The project started as a result of a number of schools being affected by torrential rains and floods, especially as they were damaged in previous years.

Hundreds of schools suffered from partial damage to complete destruction, which led to the disruption of the educational operation. Academic education was put on hold during these seasons as the remaining schools were converted into shelters for the residents whose homes were destroyed by the rain. Through this project the condition of the facility has improved by carrying out various maintenance operations or building classrooms, offices and facilities.

The project addresses the problem of students dropping out of collapsed schools or educating pressure on other schools that have taken in students from affected schools.



Education for Children with Disabilities :

Education for children with disabilities includes:

- Rehabilitation of institutes and centers for children with disabilities
- Educating the community on how to deal with children with disabilities

Sadagaat considers the education of children with disabilities a right for every child. Sadagaat began its duty with children with disabilities by adapting their institutes and centers to improve teaching methods and removing the obstacles in the educational process. This then raised community awareness on how to interact with disabled children. Sadagaat sponsored the printing of the curriculum for the blind in Braille language.



Vocational Training :

The real need for vocational training appeared when Sadagaat started the accelerated education program. Sadagaat integrates children who have dropped out of school and rejoin them with their peers at their educational level. After the students completed the basic education stage, Sadagaat's plan is to establish apprenticeships with craft institutes and factories and provide professional training that meets the needs of the work market.



Capacity Building Program for Education Staff :

Through this program, Sadagaat aims to develop the educational skills and knowledge of teachers. Professional development is provided to increase understanding of how to integrate children and youth not enrolled in education.



Academic Research :

The importance of academic research in the field of education is that it forms a solid foundation based on improving the educational process and addresses some of the challenges within the education system. Academic Research contributes to offering some solutions, especially since the Sadagaat approach is based on field studies.





Feeding

Sadagaat has been implementing the feeding axis programs through projects 'Ramadan bags', "Zakat al-Fitr" and "the sacrifice is for us and for others" and Sadagaat plays the role of intermediary for donors to deliver their Sadagaat and zakat to those who deserve it through trusted delegates. The organization follows the project from beginning to the delivery stage.



Food Sector Program

Ramadan Al Khair (Ramadan Bag) :

The Ramadan Bag Project targets families in need during the Holy Month of Ramadan. The initiative involves the distribution of Ramadan consumables to prior identified families.



Collecting Zakat Al-Fitr Funds :

The Sadagaat community receives Zakat al-Fitr donations, which are determined according to the country in which the person who pays zakat resides, to be distributed to eligible families in legal times.



The Sacrifice Is for Us and For Others :

This project requires the collection of donations from sponsors both local to Sudan and international. Calves which meet the identified conditions required for sacrifice are bought, slaughtered and distributed to families in need.





ACHIEVEMENTS



The successful completion of Sadagaat projects has been recognized for over ten years. Regardless of challenges, the determination and drive of the Sadagaat community ensured that every project undertaken came to fruition. Within the WASH, health, education and feeding programs are countless numbers of projects. Each one a success story.

Sudan is one of the countries with the highest percentage of out-of-school children in North Africa; More than **3.6 million children aged 6-13 years** do not have access to basic education, according to the Statistical Book of the Federal Ministry of Education. About **%25** of those who enter primary education do not stay in school in order to complete the full primary cycle.

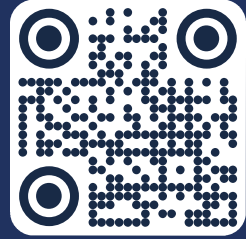
